

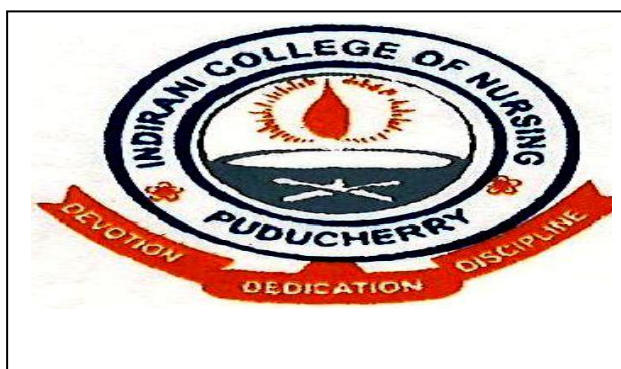

## INDIRANI COLLEGE OF NURSING

### 1. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF THE INSTITUTION:

Indirani College of nursing was established in the year 2008 under Sri Ramachandra Educational Trust with an aim to produce quality nursing education and prepare nurses with maximum radical transformation. It is affiliated to Pondicherry University and it is recognized by Indian Nursing Council and Tamilnadu Nurses and Midwives council

The College of nursing is located in Puducherry in a spacious area where 850 bedded hospital and Sri Venkateshwaraa Medical College and Research Institute are also accommodated. The eminent faculty members of college of Nursing are committed to develop nursing personnel through excellent enlightenment.

### 2. MISSION AND VISION:

- 6.2 Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing - Two Year Degree Course
- 6.3 M.Sc. Nursing – Two Years Degree Course

#### **7. ALLOCATION OF SEATS:**

- 7.1 B.Sc. Nursing - 100 seats
- 7.2 Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing - 30 seats
- 7.3 M.Sc. Nursing –20 seats

#### **8. APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION**

The application procedure for CENTAC and management differs slightly.

For CENTAC, The online application forms for admission along with information Bulletin 2015-16 can be downloaded from CENTAC website [www.centaonline.in](http://www.centaonline.in)

Applications submitted/received after the prescribed last date and time will summarily be rejected. Selection of the candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination held by university or competent authority or as per regulation of the University from time to time.

## 9. ELIGIBILITY:

### *B.Sc. Nursing*

- Candidates should have passed HSC or equivalent examination with an aggregate of 40% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English(For SC/ST candidates not less than 35% aggregate is essential)
- Should have completed 17 years of age at the time of admission.
- Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit a certificate of medical fitness from an authorized medical officer that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the academic course and does not suffer from any disability or contagious diseases.

### *B.Sc. Nursing for Trained Nurses / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing*

- Only female candidates are eligible for admission.
- Candidates should have passed Diploma in Nursing from a recognized School of Nursing.
- Should have registered with the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai.
- Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit a certificate of medical fitness from an authorized medical officer that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the academic course and does not suffer from any disability or contagious diseases.

### *M.Sc. Nursing*

- Both male and female candidates are eligible to apply.
- Candidates should have passed B.Sc Nursing Degree with 55% marks from the recognized university.
- B.Sc Nursing graduates should have at least 1 year of experience in a Teaching hospital or in a college or in a School of Nursing after registration with the Nursing Council.
- Should have registered with the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai.
- Every candidate before admission to the course shall submit a certificate of medical fitness from an authorized medical officer that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the academic course and does not suffer from any disability or contagious diseases.

**10. SELECTION AND ADMISSION:**

10.1 Admission of students to any course will be strictly on the basis of merit. Any recommendation, phone calls or attempts to meet the authorities in connection with the admission will be regarded as a disqualification.

10.2 The students for all the courses are selected on the basis of merit of the candidate in the qualifying examination.

10.3 The provisionally selected candidates will be informed by post.

10.4 The provisionally selected candidates will have to undergo a medical examination for physical fitness. If any serious defect/ illness is detected, they will be declared unfit.

10.5 Candidates provisionally selected will be intimated about the fees payable to the Institutions.

10.6 Selection intimation letters are to be surrendered to the college office at the time of paying fees.

10.7 Admission secured on the basis of false information supplied, shall stand cancelled and the fees forfeited.

10.8 All communications with office in connection with the application can be entertained only when the application name is quoted. All communications from the College will be addressed to the mailing address given in the application form, if a self addressed stamped envelope is enclosed.

10.9 Selection notification will announce the date of commencement of classes. Candidates remaining absent for three consecutive days without prior permission shall forfeit their admission as well as fees. The selected candidates should confirm the willingness for admission within the date mentioned in the selection notification.

## 11. FACILITIES AVAILABLE

11.1 **Nursing Practice:** The entire hospital complex of Sri Venkateshwara Medical College with all its various specialities having bed strength of 850 is made available to the students for clinical experience.

11.2 A well developed **Community Health Department** with urban & rural community centers with various developmental activities planned and executed scientifically are at the disposal of students for practical community health nursing experience.

11.3 Extensive **Library Service** together with systematic use of audiovisual aids, e-library is available to help the students in their learning process. They shall follow all the rules of the Library.

11.4 Individualized attention right through the programme will be provided.

11.6 **Extra Curricular Activities:** In view of the main aim of education as the total development of the person, a number of opportunities are provided for the students to develop their skills and talents at various levels, through membership to the Student and Trained Nurses Associations and participation at local, state and national conferences and scientific exhibitions which promote leadership potentialities in the students. Besides these, opportunities to develop talents in music, dance, indoor and outdoor games and sports also are provided.

11.7 **Health Services:** On admission every student will undergo a Medical Examination. An Annual check-up will be done for all the UG students. Medical care will be given to all the students in case of illness, at SVMCH as per the student health scheme, the details of which are given in the student hand book.

11.8 During the course, a high standard of health has to be maintained. In case of any illness as that of epilepsy, heart diseases and major health deviations detected after admission, the student may be asked to discontinue the course.

11.09 **Mess:** All the students of the hostel shall be required to join the mess. Booklet on rules regarding Hostel and Mess is available at the office.

11.11 **Telephone Calls:** The college does not entertain direct telephone calls to the students during working hours. Any message should be passed on through the Principal/Vice Principal / Office.

11.12 **Spoken English Class:** Provision is made for students to learn English which is a syllabus requirement and is essential to facilitate communication .

11.13 **Vacation:** Vacations are planned according to the Pondicherry University rules. If the students are unable to return on time due to illness, the Principal should be intimated immediately by telephone/email followed by a written explanation. On return, they should submit a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner stating full particulars of their illness and treatment. Normally, no other leave will be granted except the planned vacation., ***Those not having at least 80% of attendance for theory and 100% attendance for clinicals in any subject will not be permitted to appear for examination.***

11.14 **Academic Progress and Clinical Evaluation:** All Students are expected to maintain a high academic and clinical standard of performance throughout the programme. To this effect regular written and practical session examinations will be conducted. Consistent standards of excellence are expected at all times. Students who do not show any progress or who fail repeatedly will not be allowed to appear for examination / continue the course.

11.15 **Internal Assessment:** Internal assessment in each subject is carried out at prescribed times as per the weight age of the total university marks. ***Passing in the Internal assessment is the pre-requisite to appearing for the University examination.***

11.16 **Examination:** The students will appear for theory and practical examination of the Pondicherry University at the end of every academic year as prescribed. A mid-term examination and two sessional examinations will be conducted every year by the college. Examination fee, as determined by the University, should be paid by the students.

11.17 **Educational Field Visit:** During the course of studies the students will be sent for educational field visit extending over a period of 10 -15 days or more. Expenses will be borne by the students.

11.18 **Withdrawal from the Course:** As a Matter of Policy, Students are not relieved during the course of study. However, if any student after admission to the course decides to withdraw voluntarily from the college at any time before completing the course she/he shall communicate her/his decision to the Management in writing along with a letter from her/his parents in support of her/his decision. A student who fulfils these formalities and who is permitted to withdraw from the course



11.20 **Scholarship:** The students who are found academically deserving and economically backward will be considered for special assistance by the Management. Students who receive the assistance should execute a separate Service Bond which will be drawn up by the Management.

11.21 **Graduation:** On successful completion of the B.Sc. Nursing programme, the graduates are awarded the B.Sc. Nursing degree during the University convocation. Transcript, original certificates and course completion certificates are given only when the graduates meet all the course requirements of the college. The graduates are expected to register themselves with the Tamilnadu Nurses and Midwives Council and also enroll as members of TNAI. Following the successful completion of the programme, the Graduates will have Graduation ceremony in the Institution. No student who has failed in the final exams will be allowed for graduation march. Applicants/Parents/Guardians are informed that it will not be possible to enter into correspondence with them in connection with the various provisions in the prospectus. It is also not possible to grant them an interview in this connection. All decisions or actions taken by the Management are final and not subject to review.

## **12. GENERAL DISCIPLINE:**


Nursing Profession, which demands altruistic service from its members, exacts self discipline at a personal level and general discipline in the campus. Therefore:

12.1 Regular attendance as well as punctuality is expected from the students at lectures, demonstrations, practical's, field work and other such academic exercise as well as experiences. They are required to attend allotted working periods in each of the prescribed subjects.

12.2 Students should wear the prescribed complete uniform for duty.

12.3 A sense of decorum and discipline is expected to every student in the college, hospital as well as in the entire campus.

**Ragging is strictly prohibited.** They shall not indulge either individually or collectively, in any form of activity that will bring down the good name of the Institution / Nursing profession.



12.4 Students will strive at all costs to be loyal to the Ethos of the Institution and to promote its image and status by a humane, ethical and professional code of conduct. Failure to follow these and such other regulations will necessitate the management to take disciplinary action as deemed fit.

**13. FEES:**

13.1 The fees will be charged based on the expenses incurred on education and other facilities offered. Students are expected to meet the expenses.
